As a record for posterity's sake , the following trees were planted :

- 68 Eucalyptus radiata (Narrow-leafed Peppermint)
- 96 E. obliqua (Messmate)
- 128 E. globulus (Blue Gum)
- 108 E. viminalis (Manna Gum)
- 28 Acacia melanoxylon (Blackwood)
- 96 A. dealbata (Silver Wattle)
- 36 A. verticillata (Prickly Moses)

Let's maintain the momentum. Our next tree planting day is Sunday, June 16. We are again meeting at the end of Tebb Tce. at 10:00 a.m. You're welcome to come and go as you please throughout the day: if you arrive after 10, just follow the signs. If you are going to be there over lunch, bring a packed lunch or stuff for a barbecue .
